### **Opening of the Meeting**

The meeting of the Pakistan Full Contact Karate Federation (PFKF) was held on 17th May, 2026 at Delicia Hotel, Gujranwala, Pakistan. The meeting commenced with the recitation of the Holy Quran, recited by Farhan Ali.

### **Welcome Speech**

After the recitation, the participants were warmly welcomed by Shihan Muhammad Arshad Jan, who delivered the welcome speech and highlighted the importance of unity, discipline, and promotion of Full Contact Karate in Pakistan under the affiliation and guidance of WFKO-Japan.

### **Presentation of Reports**

Mr. Muhammad Nasir Khan presented the detailed report of Pakistan Full Contact Karate Federation (PFKF) and World Full Contact Karate Organization (WFKO). The report included discussion regarding:

## Objections Raised During Election

### 1. First Objection:

- Mr. Zahoor Hashmi raised an objection regarding the seat of Senior Vice President. After detailed discussion and consultation, the house unanimously agreed to revise the initial voting decision.
- Consequently, the seat of Senior Vice President was awarded to Mr. Syed Shakeel Ahmad, while the position of Vice President was assigned to Mr. Qasim Hussain.

### 2. Second Objection:

- Mr. M. Adeel Raja raised an objection regarding the position of Mr. Sher Zaman. He proposed that Mr. Sher Zaman should be appointed as Vice President instead of Executive Member on the basis of seniority.
- After discussion, the house unanimously rejected the objection and maintained the decision of the federation accordingly.

## Decisions and Resolutions

After completion of the election process, the following important decisions and resolutions were unanimously approved by the house:

1. **First Full Contact Karate Championship:** It was unanimously decided that the 1st Full Contact Karate Championship will be conducted at Wah Cantt, District Rawalpindi. While the final date of commencement of the championship shall be decided after Eid holidays.
2. **Referee Courses:** The house also decided that Referee Courses shall be organized before the said championship/event. Only selected and certified referees shall be allowed to participate in any official event, championship, or tournament organized under PFKF.
3. **Discipline During Competitions:** A very important issue regarding discipline during competitions was discussed. The house unanimously decided that no fighter, coach, or team official shall be allowed to raise objections against referee decisions during any event, championship, or tournament. In case of violation of this rule, the entire team shall be disqualified.
4. **Selection for International Championships:** The house further resolved that only selected fighters/participants shall be eligible to participate in upcoming World and Asian Championships.
5. **Organization of Training Camps:** It was also decided that all Branch Chiefs and other members of the federation shall organize Full Contact Karate Training Camps in their respective regions. All Kyokushin organizations shall be encouraged to participate in these camps for enhancement of karate training, techniques, and mutual cooperation.

## Closing Remarks

At the conclusion of the meeting, the President thanked all members and participants for their valuable presence, cooperation, and commitment towards the promotion of Full Contact Karate in Pakistan.

The meeting ended with mutual appreciation and best wishes for the success and development of PFKF.
